PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

Operate and maintain all mechanical equipment on the *MV Kulanda* barge including engines and lifting gear and provide appropriate logs and recording keeping.

KEY DUTIES

- Man the *MV Kulanda* and operate the necessary plant and equipment
- Maintain the vessel by carrying out routine maintenance, overhauls and modifications
- Maintain tidiness of vessel and housekeeping
- Complete maintenance tasks, including painting, deck and or engine room maintenance, rope splicing etc
- Watch keeping and vessel keeping duties as directed by vessel Master
- Adhere to all Tasports health, safety and environment requirements including the reporting of near misses and hazards as well as the use of correct Personal Protective Equipment at all times required
- When the *MV Kulanda* is not in use:
 - Assist with the slipping of vessels at the Domain Slip-yard
 - Undertake maintenance works at the Domain Slip-yard and at other TasPorts sites in Hobart
 - Operate and maintain, within competency, other TasPorts floating plant as required
- Perform other duties as required in accordance with qualifications and competence including acting as the Engineer of the vessel when required

LEVEL OF RESPONSIBILITY / ACCOUNTABILITY

This position operates under the direction of the Master and Ports Operations Coordinator. The incumbent is required to work under general supervision and at times, with a high degree of independence and autonomy. The incumbent is responsible for identifying solutions and solving problems relating to their area of work. They must possess the appropriate practical and theoretical knowledge and skills required to perform tasks relating to the operation of the vessel including deck hand duties. Flexibility regarding working hours to meet coastal sailing times and overnight stays is a requirement of this position. Operate under general supervision and possess basic typing, computer and keyboard skills.
