

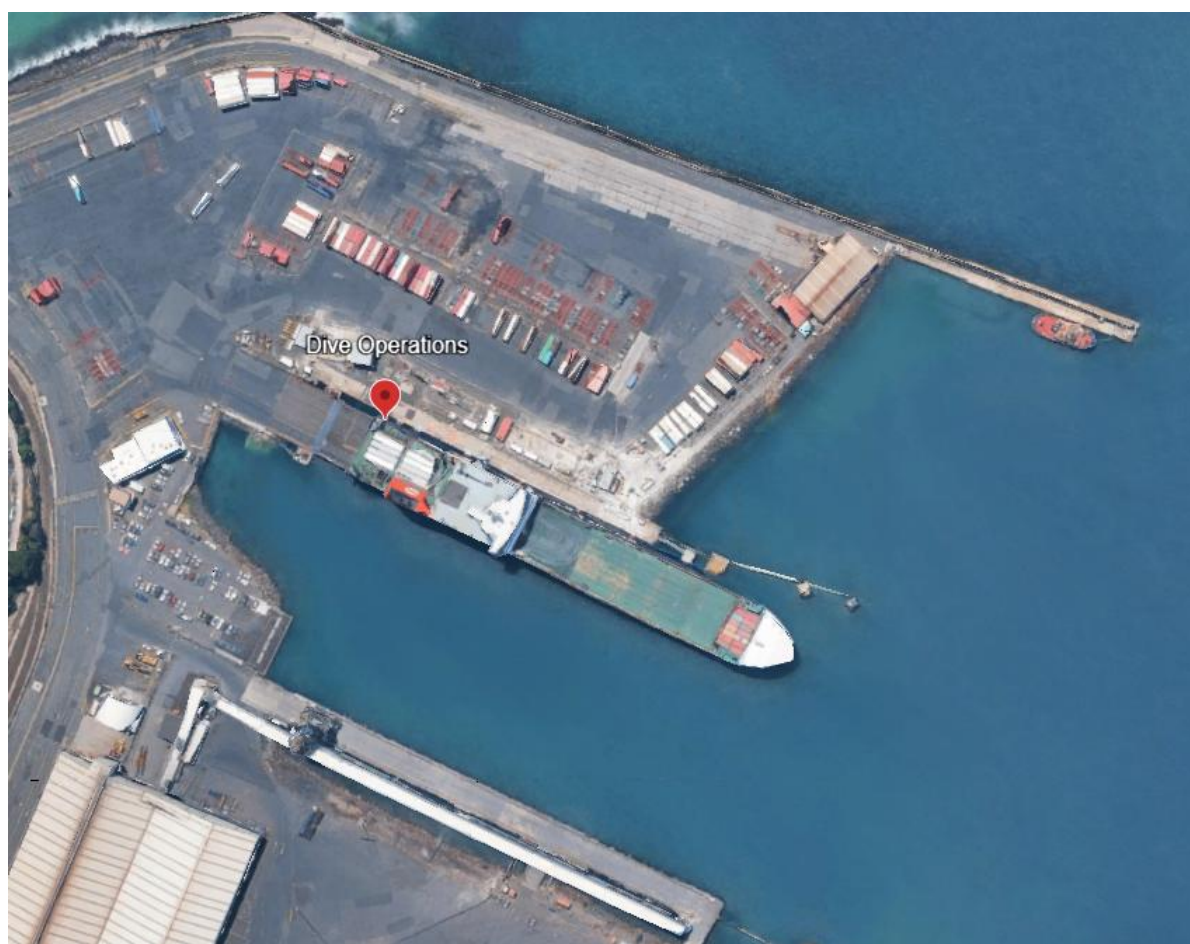
Title: Berth 4 – Dive Operations
Port: Port of Burnie
Duration: Mon 03/08 – Sun 09/08/2026

Description:

Mariners are advised that contractors **Total Dive Solutions** will be undertaking dive operations at Burnie Berth 4 Mon 03 August through Sun 09 August 2026 inclusive.

The dive location is in the vicinity of the following position:

Longitude 41°03.023'S, Latitude 145°54.661'E



Total Dive Solutions are to contact Burnie VTS prior to commencement and upon completion of dive operations each day.

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HARBOUR MASTERS INSTRUCTION

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Divers are to be clear of the water at least 30 mins prior to the POB time for inbound scheduled shipping, or 30 mins prior to scheduled departure of scheduled shipping, and to advise **Burnie VTS** when clear of the water, and prior to re-entering to the water.

The dive support team are to maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch 14 whilst undertaking dive operations in port waters.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear of the diving operation marked by the International Code Signal Flag "A", maintain a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 120 m of the dive site, and navigate with caution.
