


Title: Geo-Technical Drilling Operations

Details:

TasPorts in conjunction with Bridge Pro Engineering will be undertaking core sampling and Geo Technical drilling in the Port of Burnie.

Mariners are advised that the works will be conducted from the BridgePro Jack up Barge (JUB) with associated work boats in attendance.

Works in proximity to operating berths will be done in accordance with berth availability allowing for cargo operations to be undertaken safely.

The JUB and workboats will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16 and marked and lit accordingly. Mariners are requested to give the operation a wide berth and maintain as slow speed on passing the various drill hole sights as noted in the plan below.
