Title: Salvage Operations – 3W Devonport – Dive activities

Port: Port of Devonport

References: MAST NtoM M053-22 – Port of Devonport – Mersey River - Prohibited Area

HMI 22-09 is hereby cancelled

Description:

Duration: till 12th May 2022.

Diving activities associated with wreck salvage works are taking place at Devonport berth **3 WEST**. Divers will initially work a perimeter extending 50m from the wreck site, then concentrate efforts on the tug wrecks.

A prohibited area is established under MAST Notice to Mariners.

Dive Team

- Provide VTS with approved and signed Dive Permit for works.
- To advise VTS prior to commencement of daily dive activities, and on completion.
- During diving activities flag Alpha "A" will be displayed.
- Diving activities are to cease during the arrival and departure of commercial vessels and to advise VTS when divers are within a safe area.
- Dive activities may resume once outbound vessels are passing Mussel Rock.
- To advise VTS of any emergency incidents associated with dive activities.

Devonport VTS

- To advise dive team daily scheduled shipping movements at start of dive operations.
- To advise dive team update of changes to scheduled days shipping movements.
- To advise dive team 30min notice of a scheduled shipping movement.
- To advise dive team when outbound movements are passing Mussel Rock Beacon.

Tugs

Are to advise VTS when approaching the 3W wreck site, and take a wide berth.

Communications

Primary contacts are provided below, additionally when the dive team are operational, they are to maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14 for situational awareness and back-up communications.
