Description:

As part of the development of the new TT-Line terminal Hazell Brady Joint Venture (HBJV) will be undertaking marine and land-based demolition and construction work in and around Devonport 3 East berth. The marine works will be undertaken within the construction zone indicated below:



Berth 3 East Marine Construction Boundary

Barges, vessels, buoys and plant will be utilized during this works. Larger HBJV marine craft are fitted with AIS and will maintain a listening watch on VHF 14 when operational.

All port vessels are to remain outside the construction boundary except for vessels required to utilise the swing basin. Such vessels must obtain approval from DEVONPORT VTS prior to arrival and departure.

Scheduled Shipping Movements:

- Scheduled arrival shipping movements are directed to call DEVONPORT VTS when entering DEVONPORT VTS Area and again at least 30 mins prior to crossing into Port Limits.
- Scheduled departure shipping movements are directed to call DEVONPORT VTS at least one hour prior to their intended departure.
