Title: WSCAM subsea inspections

Port: Port of Devonport

Duration: Mon 26th May – 01 July 2025

Description:

TD Consulting and ROVing Intelligence will be commencing WSCAM subsea inspections in the Port of Devonport on Monday 26th May 2025.

The works involve using a Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) for subsea asset inspections at the following wharves:

- Devonport 1 East
- Devonport 1 West
- Devonport 4 West
- Devonport 5 West
- Devonport Slipway

The inspection location will vary subject to berth availability.

Works at Dev 1 East will be undertaken of a night to align with TT Line and the 'Spirit of Tasmania' Sailing. This portion of works is scheduled to commence the week of 23rd June.

Works include inwater visual inspection, high pressure water cleaning, ultrasonic thickness testing, and anode inspections. A small craft will be utilized to complete initial inspections at each berth to ensure alignment with TasPorts drawings and documentation.

The Inspection Team are to advise **DEVONPORT VTS** prior to the ROV going into the water, when the ROV leaves the water, and prior to being relocated between inspection sites.

A dive flag "Alpha" is to be displayed at the inspection location to signify the underwater operations.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear and navigate with caution.
