

Title: Macquarie Wharf 4, 5 & 6 – Bathymetric Survey

Port: Port of Hobart

Description: Works commencing: **Friday, 23rd February 2024**
 Works complete: **Wednesday, 28th February 2024**

Fulcrum Robotics will be undertaking remote bathymetric survey under Macquarie Wharf No 4, 5 & 6 from the vessel **REGULATOR** across the course of a scheduled timeframe.

Contractors are to contact **HOBART VTS** on VHF ch 12:

- Prior to commencement of days work, and
- On completion of days work.

HOBART VTS are to advise of any expected vessel movements likely to affect survey works.

Contractor works crew/s are to maintain a listening watch on VHF 12 at all times whilst working under or alongside the wharf.

No works are to be undertaken:

- alongside a vessel on a wharf, or within 40m of the vessel;
- within 30 minutes of the intended movement of a vessel on an adjacent wharf;
- or as advised by TasPorts Operations, or Hobart VTS.

International Code Flags – the Contractors are to hoist international code flags **R over Y** when on water / while survey is being undertaken. These flags are to be taken down at the completion of each days work.

Mariners are advised to keep well clear, proceed at a slow speed (< 5 kts) when passing within 60m of a marine facility, and to minimise wash.

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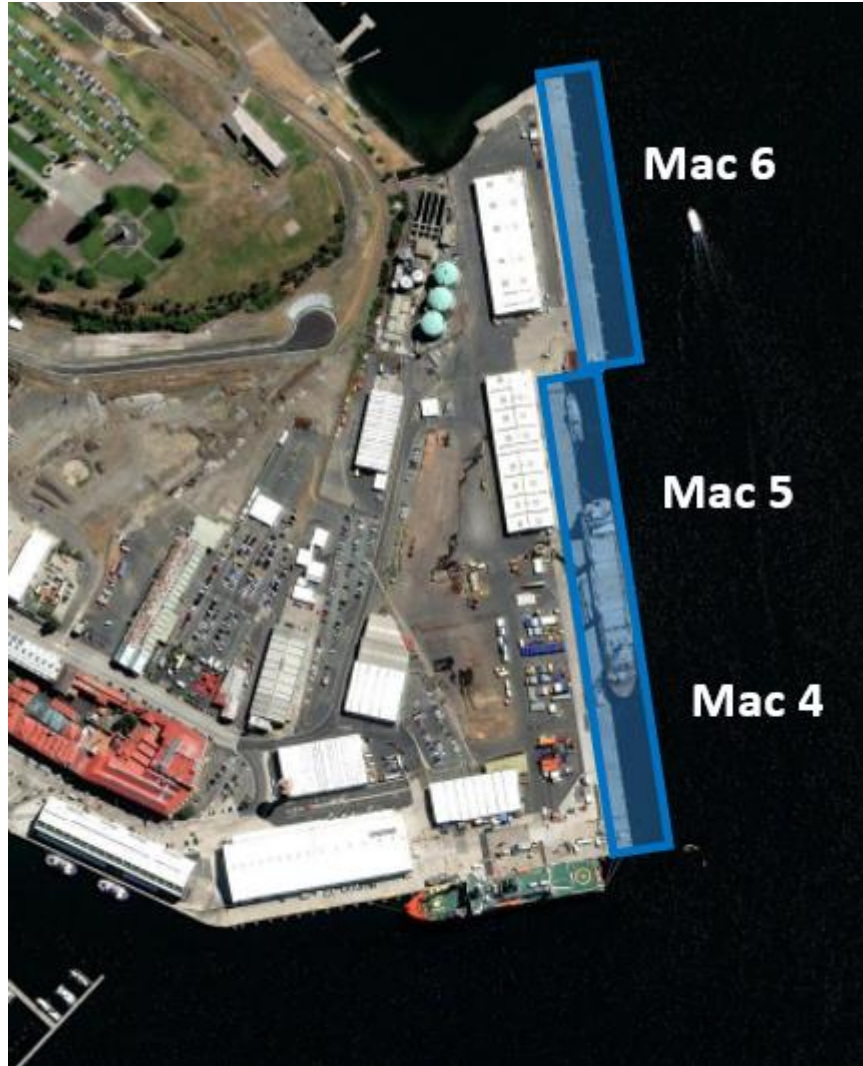


Figure 1 – Works Areas
