Title: Seabed Levelling – Burnie Harbour
Port: Port of Burnie
Duration: 11 June – 24 June 2026

Description:

Mariners are advised that seabed levelling will be undertaken within Burnie Harbour during the period 11 June till 24 June 2026.

The seabed levelling works will include the Burnie Swing Basin, Berth approach corridors and berth pockets.

The seabed levelling will be undertaken by the tug **MOLLY GRACE**, which will work around scheduled commercial shipping operations.

The tug **MOLLY GRACE** is to cease seabed leveling operations 30 mins prior to the arrival at Port Limits of expected shipping, or 30 mins prior to the expected departure of shipping, and is to remain well clear of shipping movements within Burnie Harbour.

The tug **MOLLY GRACE** is to advise **BURNIE VTS** at the following times:

- At the start of each day's seabed levelling operations.
- When seabed levelling operations have ceased for expected shipping movements.
- On completion of each day's seabed levelling operations.

The tug **MOLLY GRACE** is to maintain a listening watch on VHF ch 14 whilst underway within the Port of Burnie.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear and navigate with caution.
