

**Title:** Mersey River navigation aid maintenance  
**Port:** Port of Devonport  
**Duration:** 04 May – 10 June 2026

### Description:

Mariners are advised that navigation aid maintenance will be undertaken in the Mersey River during the above period.

Works will take place for the replacement of Beacon platforms for

- Beacon #2 (ALRS Vol K 3557),
- Beacon #3 (ALRS Vol K 3556.2) and
- the reinstatement of Beacon #9 (ALRS Vol K 3559.4).

Works will be performed from the vessel **KULANDA**.

**KULANDA** will deploy a number of anchors to assist with holding the vessel in position for the works. The anchors will be marked by unlit yellow buoys.

- **KULANDA** is to contact **DEVONPORT VTS** via VHF ch 14 prior to the start of each on-water working day, when clear of the channel for scheduled shipping, and on completion of each on-water working day.
- **KULANDA** is to liaise with **DEVONPORT VTS** and have the vessel, anchors and buoys removed from the channel 1 hr prior to all scheduled shipping movements.
- **KULANDA** is to maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch 14 during on-water works.

Mariners are requested to keep well clear and navigate with caution.
